## How do I build polygon regions in ds9?

- 1. Select "polygon" from the "Region -> Shape" menu.
- 2. Click and drag to draw a box on the image.
- 3. Select the box and double squares will appear at the corners.
- 4. The outer set of corner squares indicate that the standard region functions are active:
  - ♦ Delete region: use <DELETE> key
  - ♦ Move region: use left mouse button (symbol: cross)
  - ♦ Resize region: use left mouse button (symbol: box + arrows)
- 5. The inner set of corner squares allow you to add vertices to the shape:
  - ♦ Place cursor on any line segment at desired vertex location
  - ♦ Click left mouse button to create the vertex
  - ♦ Move vertex with left mouse button (symbol: box within box)
