Synopsis

Remove objects from the stack

Syntax

```
_pop_n (Integer_Type n);
```

Description

The `_pop_n` function pops `n` objects from the top of the stack.

Example

```
define add3 ()
{
  variable x, y, z;
  if (_NARGS != 3)
  {
    _pop_n (_NARGS);
    error ("add3: Expecting 3 arguments");
  }
  (x, y, z) = ();
  return x + y + z;
}
```
