Synopsis

Causes the specified 2–D data to be displayed, using the default imaging display tool (i.e. ds9)

Syntax

```
chips> DISPLAY <filename>
```

Description

The <filename> is the name of an image data file, and may include a directory path. Currently, only 2–D FITS images are supported.

Example

```
chips> DISPLAY data/example_img.fits
```

Displays the image contained in data/example_img.fits.
