Synopsis

Remove whitespace from the ends of a string

Syntax

```
String_Type strtrim (String_Type s [,String_Type w])
```

Description

The strtrim function removes all leading and trailing whitespace characters from the string *s* and returns the result. The optional second parameter specifies the set of whitespace characters. If the argument is not present, then the set defaults to "`\t\r\n`".
